Hello! Thanks so much for signing up the class! I appreciate your adventurous spirit and curious nature. Here are the details...

Choose your Device

Plan to join the class using a device that you can keep near you in your sewing space. *The larger the screen the better for your visibility.* Think about how you will keep it powered during class.

After you have decided on your device, make sure you have the free Zoom software installed. If your device is a laptop or desktop computer, please visit <https://www.zoom.us/download> to download and install. This is a free download and you will not need to register. If you will join from a tablet or phone, please visit your app store and download the free Zoom app. Do this prior to the event so you don't miss anything! If you would like to check that you did this step correctly you can join a [Zoom Test Meeting](#) anytime to make sure.

Joining the Class

When you register, and again the day before the class, you will receive an email that includes a link to the private Zoom class meeting. When you are ready to join the class on the class day, click the link in your reminder email. You will see a pop-up message asking if you want to open the link in Zoom. **Click "Allow"**.

The classroom will open 15 minutes prior to the official class starting time to allow you to get settled with your technology and connect with me about any questions you have. If you have not joined the class by the meeting start time you may have to wait for me to let you in while I begin class introductions. Try to get in the class at least a couple minutes early!

Magic Triangle Workshop

Supply list

- Rotary cutter and mat
- Small scissors
- Pins
- Iron and ironing surface
- Pressing spray or spray starch
- Colored pencils for planning your design.
- Thread
- Machine: a quarter inch piecing foot is recommended.
- Book: Wedge Quilt Workshop (optional, but you'll be glad you did! If you like making these blocks there is a quilt in the book made entirely of magic triangles. You can purchase a digital copy of the book [here](#))
- Wedge ruler: A printable 10-degree wedge template is included. Cut both the templates out carefully if you are using these. You will also need some clear tape to attach them to your ruler (we will go over this in class). If you have an acrylic wedge ruler, that is even easier to use than templates! I recommend the **Creative Grids 10-degree Triangle** ruler.


Fabric requirements

You can use any fabric you want to play with!


Fabric to be used for wedges should be at least 9" wide. 10" squares would be perfect if you have them. 8 squares would be enough.

Fabric to be used for triangle points should be at least 4 1/2" wide. One width-of-fabric strip will be enough to complete the table topper.


I invite you to follow your design instincts. Pull scraps if that is how you like to work. Pull 1/2 yard of neutral fabric if you think you might like to change the nature of the designs with negative space. We will have fun and your creation will be utterly yours!
